The Southern New Mexico Square Dance Community lost two of it's beloved friends this summer, Wilson Purcella and Gerald Tibbs.



# Wilson Purcella May 8, 1940 — June 3, 2007

Wilson will be greatly missed by our Square Dance Community. I am not sure when Wilson began dancing and learning to call, but I'm pretty sure it was some time after he was transferred from Roswell. I am certain that he was a member and learned to call at Blue Bell Square Dance Club. Most everyone who worked for "Ma Bell" in Las Cruces were members of Blue Bell Square Dance Club at one time or another, and a great many of them were callers. Wilson went on to call for almost every club in the Southwest District. He was an accomplished caller and instructor. He taught everything from Basic through Advanced. In May of 2004 he was inducted into the New Mexico Square Dance Hall of Fame. Before he became ill he was calling for clubs in Las Cruces, Silver City, Deming, and Alamogordo. Our hearts go out to his family for their loss. Thank you for sharing your father and grandfather with us.

# Gerald Tibbs November 11th, 1943 — June 29th, 2007

Gerald had just recently begun to return to square dancing. Gerald was just beginning to recover from the loss of his wife Mary several years ago. He lost Mary after a long battle with breast cancer. He had also begun playing his fiddle with his long time friend from Hot Springs New Mexico, Pat Pendergrass. Gerald and Mary were members of Blue Bell Square Dance Club and this is where he began calling. He too was an employee of Mountain Bell who was introduced to Square Dancing and calling at Blue Bell Square Dance Club. I believe that Gerald started the "Traveling Twirlers" Plus club in the mid 1970's. Our hearts go out to his family for their loss. Thank you Gerald for sharing your life with all of us.
